

The Loomis Endowed Academic Award in

The Groton Endowed Academic Award in

*The Department of Classics at St. Olaf College announces the 21st annual **Loomis Latin Award** competition and the 20th annual **Groton Greek Award** competition.*

First prize (\$300), second prize (\$200), and third prize (\$100) in each contest will be determined by performance on a one-hour sight-translation exam.

Both one-hour exams will be given on Wednesday, May 4, 2022, in Tomson 314 between 3 and 9 p.m. Stop by the Classics Department any time between 3 and 8 p.m. to obtain a copy of the exam (or exams, if you would like to take both). No Latin or Greek dictionaries, grammar books, or other translation aids, in either print or electronic format, are permitted.

Winners will be announced by Sunday, May 15, 2022.

Any current St. Olaf College student is eligible to take one or both of the exams, but only those who have studied Latin or ancient Greek beyond the elementary level are likely to do well.
